**Transnational Project Workshop (TPW) Summary**

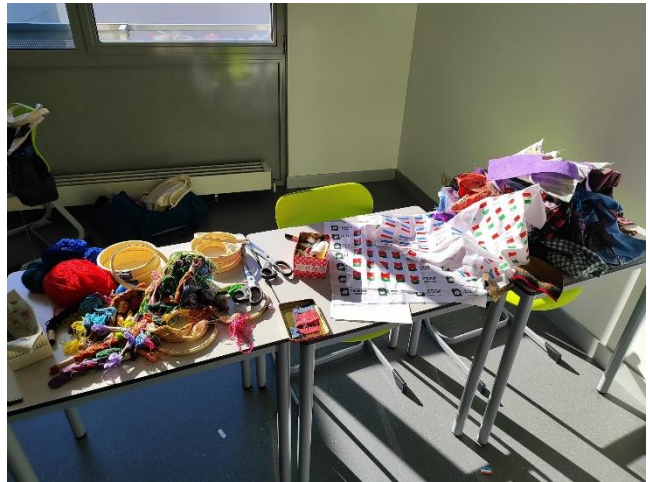
**March 17<sup>th</sup>**

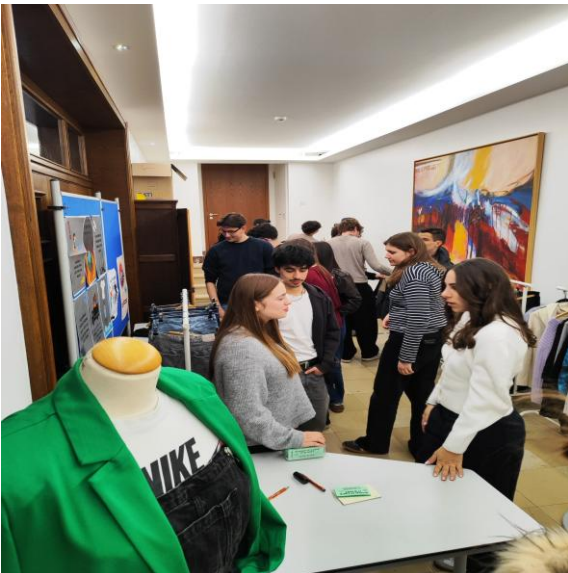

- Europa Experience: All together in Parliament, getting ready for the debate session. Role-play activity

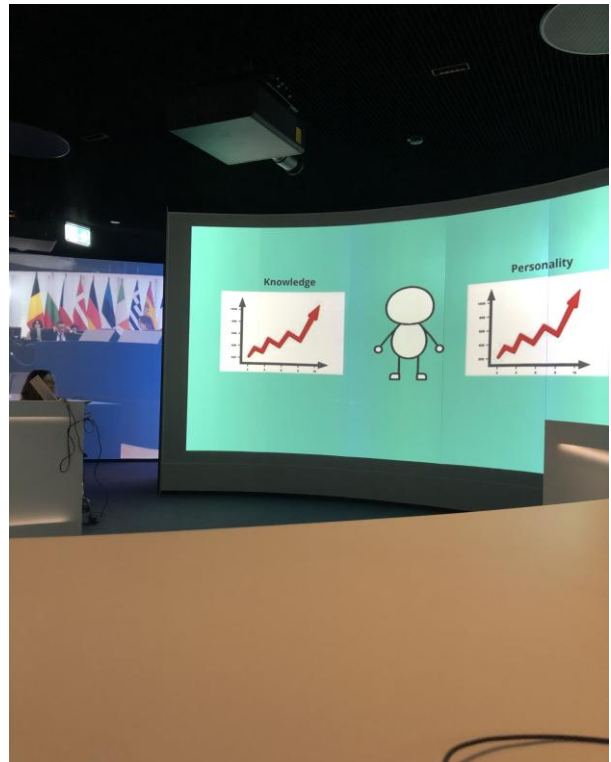
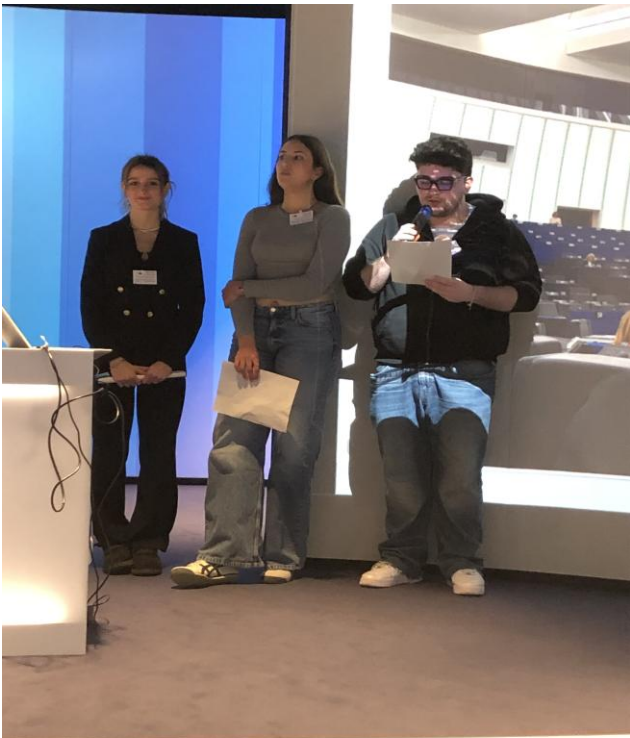
